

# 2023 MASTER OF PERIOPERATIVE MEDICINE M6033

## DEPARTMENT OF ANAESTHESIOLOGY AND PERIOPERATIVE MEDICINE

### OVERVIEW

The course is designed to facilitate the delivery of collaborative and optimal perioperative care to patients presenting with complex, chronic and acute medical conditions requiring surgical intervention by physicians working in the emerging field of perioperative medicine. The course adopts an evidence base and risk-informed approach to the justification of perioperative medical interventions within the modern surgical setting. Additionally, the course aims to develop an understanding of the role of human factors and clinical leadership within this emerging medical discipline.

This course is recommended for medical practitioners who manage patients in the perioperative period, and those who want to improve practice in this area.
